


Evolution of American Political Parties

6. John Zuincy Adams (1825-1829)

Changed their name to <u>WHIGS</u> to change their image

- 13) Millard Fillmore
- (1850-1853)

The refusal of the WHIGS to make a stand on the issue of slavery ruins them.

SPLIT

DEMOCRATS (same as today)

- 7) Andrew Jackson (1829-1837)
- 8) Martin Van Buren (1837-1841)

Panic of 1837 throws votes to the new Whig Party.

Polk runs on "Annex Texas" policy

- 11) James X. Polk (1845-1849)
- 14) Franklin Pierce (1853-1857)
- 15) James Buchanan (1857-1861)

The Republican's anti-slavery stand and the Democratic splitticket of Southern Democrats and Northern Democrats throws the election to Abraham Lincoln; and the nation into a Civil War.
